III. Facilities:

The Institute at present is functioning from its temporary premises located at Bishop Cotton Road, Shillong. There are two Kitchens attached to the Institute. The Institutes has more than six class rooms for holding classes. Besides it is equiped with computer labs with internet facilities and Library. The Institute is also having a Training Centre to add more skills to the students.

Auditors' Report

We have audited the annexed Balance Sheet of the INSTITUTE OF HOTEL MANAGEMENT CATERING TECHNOLOGY AND APPLIED NUTRITION: LUMPYNGAD: BISHOP COTTON ROAD: SHILLONG-793001, Main account as on 31st March 2011 and the annexed consolidated Income & Expenditure Account for the year ended on that date. These financial statements are the responsibility of the Institute's governing body. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

We have conducted our audit in accordance with the standards generally accepted in India. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free of material misstatements. An audit includes examining on a test check basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by managment, as well as evaluating the overall financial statement presentation. We believe that our Audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.

We have obtained all the information and explanations, which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of our audit.

In our opinion, the institute has maintained proper books of accounts as required by law and as appears from our examination of those books.

In our opinion and to the best of our knowledge and information and according to the explanations given to us and as shown by the books of accounts, we report that:

- i. The books of accounts as maintained by the Institute require improvement as far as creation of separate accounting heads for distinguishing between capital and revenue items of expenditure.
- ii. Interests on Fixed deposits have been accounted for on realization basis.
- iii. Transactions of activities carried out on behalf of IGNOU and JEE needs to be separately maintained.
- iv. The Institute deducts from its staff's salaries certain sums of money on account of their retirement benefits, which are being regurlarly remitted to a savings bank account held with Vijaya Bank, Shillong. However, the Institute must follow the provisions of the Provident Fund Act.
- v. The physical implementations of Civil Construction were not verified by us.
- vi. The Institute also has a separate CBSP account including bank which is not incorporated in the above account. Funds are taken from CBSP account to the Main account in case of necessity and subsequently refunded. The net balance of CBSP account is shown as advance with CBSP.

Subject to the above and read with the notes thereon, the said account gives a true and fair view:-

- (i) in the case of the Balance Sheet, of the state of the affairs of the Institute as at 31st March, 2011 and
- (ii) in the case of the Income and Expenditure account of the surplus of the Institute for the year ended on that date.
